

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF BLIND RIVER  
BY-LAW NO. 24-13**

Being a By-law to amend By-Law 21-67 for the Corporation of the Town of Blind River being a By-Law to regulate traffic within the Town of Blind River.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 130 of the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, authorizes the Council of a local municipality to pass a By-Law relating to the health, safety and well-being of the inhabitants of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 5.3 of the Municipal; Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, the powers of every Council shall be exercised by by-law;

WHEREAS Council has enacted by-law 21-67 being a by-law to regulate traffic within the Town of Blind River;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Blind River enacts as follows:


