## ACCEPTED

### HOUSEHOLD WASTE

Should be properly bagged and tied close.  
Examples: Food scraps, paper waste, glass bottles, beverage cans etc.

## NOT-ACCEPTED

### CONSTRUCTION WASTE

Examples: Wood, drywall, insulation etc.

### HAZARDOUS WASTE

Examples: batteries, fridges, freezers, paint solvents, etc.

### FURNITURE

Examples: mattresses, couches, desks etc.

### WASTE LEFT OUTSIDE OF THE DUMPSTER

Examples: large items, bags etc.



# BLIND RIVER ACCEPTS A NUMBER OF WASTE STREAMS AT THE LANDFILL FOR NO COST

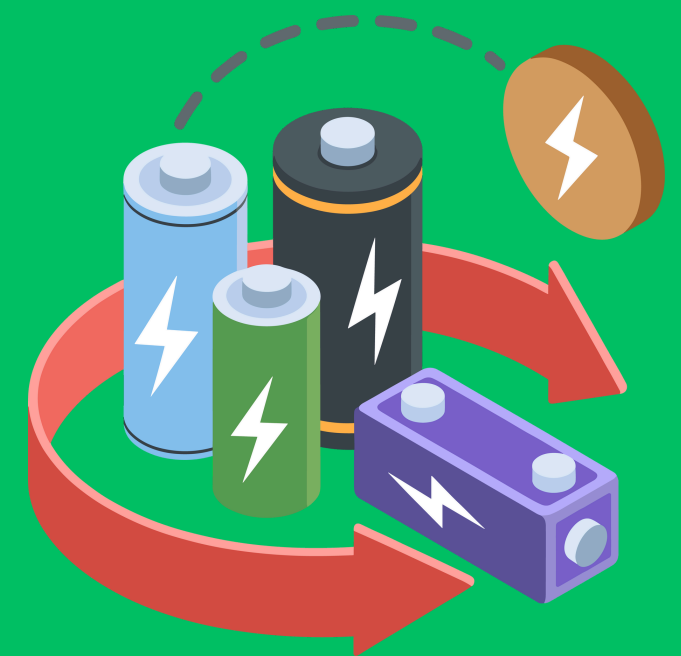
## E-WASTE (ELECTRONICS)

- TV
- Microwaves
- Light Fixtures (Fluorescent bulbs not accepted)
- Anything with a plug or cord that uses power and related accessories



## CONSUMER BATTERIES

All household consumer batteries are accepted at the landfill



## NATURAL WOOD

Natural wood and brush are accepted at the landfill at no charge. Painted, stained or chemically treated wood is subject to a fee



## SCRAP METAL

Scrap metal and metal appliances are accepted at no cost
