Reporting directly to the Director of Facilities and Community Services and working with excellent municipal staff, the successful candidate must be capable of assisting the Recreation Department with cleaning and other related janitorial duties, ice maintenance, safe operation of all related equipment including the ice resurfer, attending to boaters and visitors to the Marine Park, as well as working closely with summer students. In addition, the Arena & Marina Attendant will participate in the general maintenance program of the Municipality and other related duties.

The successful candidate must demonstrate exemplary interpersonal, organizational and communication skills and be capable of working independently and as part of a team.

The ideal candidate should possess:

- Completion of secondary school diploma, or equivalent.
- Ability to manage workload and work independently with minimal supervision.
- Ability to perform duties requiring medium level of physical effort, including but not limited to moving garbage, cleaning, vacuuming, and shoveling.
- Ability to operate mechanical equipment (ex: trucks, VHF Radio (training to be supplied if not certified), and waste collection. Maintain all equipment properly)
- Ability to communicate effectively, orally and in writing, as required.
- Interpersonal skills.
- Knowledge of basic building security procedures.
- Basic computer skills an asset.
- A valid G Class Driver's License.
- Ability to work a flexible schedule; weekends, afternoons, stat holidays, and dayshifts are required
